

St Thomas is the capital of the U.S. Virgin Islands and the port of Charlotte Amalie is the capital of St Thomas. Historic buildings found throughout downtown Charlotte Amalie take visitors back to the Danish era when the town was a bustling port of trade. Sugar trade brought prosperity in the early 19th century but today, with the addition of souvenir vendors and cruise ships in the harbour it is evident that it is tourism that currently drives the economy. Charlotte Amalie is home to almost half of the islands 51,000+ residents. The island is just 32 square miles and is largely mountainous. Take a ride in an open-air cab, also known as a "safari cab" or plan to take the cable car up the side of the mountain for a terrific panoramic view of the island and ocean. St. Thomas is a water lover's paradise so you may plan a day of snorkelling, scuba diving, windsurfing, a day charter, kite boarding, sailing, fishing, kayaking or parasailing. If you are more a land lover, play a round of golf, take an island tour, check out some attractions, take in the historical sites downtown and do some shopping.
